Do you need a power plug adapter on Sint Maarten?

On Sint Maarten, they use power sockets (outlets) of type A and B, like in the United States. You need a power plug adapter on Sint Maarten for sockets type A. Sockets type B can fit your plugs, but may not always be available locally. We don't sell power plug adapters.

What type of plugs does Sint Maarten use?

Sint Maarten uses power outlets and plugs of types A & B. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Do the outlets look different in your country? You'll need a power plug adapter. Type A - Mostly used in the US, Canada, Mexico, Central America, China and Japan.

What type of power socket does Sint Maarten use?

The power sockets on Sint Maarten are of type A and B. The standard voltage is 110 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. You need a power plug (travel) adapter on Sint Maarten.

Does Sint Maarten have a travel adapter?

Plugs of type A will also fit into a type B socket. If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in Sint Maarten, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter. All power sockets in Sint Maarten provide a standard voltage of 110V with a standard frequency of 60Hz.

What type of electricity is used in Sint Maarten?

Plugs for Sint Maarten are: Type A: A two-prong plug with two flat parallel pins. There is no earth connection. It is sometimes called the "NEMA connector".
