

How much solar power does Principe have?

The island of Principe has solar irradiation levels that range from 700 to 1000 kWh/m²/year. The average daily photovoltaic power output is 3.72 kWh per installed kWp [82]. Fig. 18 shows a map of the solar resources on the island.

Who owns Sao Tome & Principe?

Petrobras has acquired stakes in three blocks offshore Sao Tome & Principe, under a deal with Shell. Under the agreement, the Brazilian company has acquired 45% stakes in Blocks 10 and 13, and 25% in Block 11. Shell is the operator of the three blocks with a 40% stake, while ANP-STP has 15% stakes. Galp has a 20% interest in Block 11.

Does Sao Tome and Principe have a right to education?

The Human Rights Measurement Initiative (HRMI) finds that Sao Tome and Principe is fulfilling only 83.8% of its expected commitments to the right to education based on the country's level of income. HRMI breaks down the right to education by looking at the rights to both primary education and secondary education.

Is EMAE dragging down the economy of São Tomé & Príncipe?

The troubles afflicting utility EMAE are dragging down the economy of the island nation. The United Nations Development Program is seeking consultants to conduct feasibility studies for a 2 MW solar project and three mini hydropower plants ranging in size from 1.15-2 MW in São Tomé and Príncipe.

Is Shell acquiring Kosmos Energy in Sao Tome?

Shell entered Sao Tome in 2019, on Blocks 6 and 11. It then acquired Kosmos Energy's local interests, giving it entry into Blocks 10 and 13, in 2020. ANP-STP announced a plan to bring in a partner on its Block 4, in October this year. Farmout Angel reports that the agency is offering 85% to partners in the block, while also offering Block 2.
