Georgia Power continues to work with the Georgia PSC to procure and develop BESS projects across Georgia. In addition to the Mossy Branch facility, Georgia Power is developing the 265 MW McGrau Ford Phase I BESS project in Cherokee County. This project was approved in the 2022 IRP, and Georgia Power expects it to enter service by the end of 2026.

Georgia Power has inaugurated the first battery energy storage system (BESS) project the US utility company has built to own and operate. A ceremony was held last week (7 November) at the Mossy Branch Battery Facility site in Georgia's Talbot County.

Once developed, the four-hour BESS projects will "serve as dispatchable capacity resources that will provide customers with a reliable and economical source of electricity for the winter of 2026/2027," the utility said in a statement. These projects include the 128 MW Robins BESS located in Bibb County, adjacent to an existing solar farm.
