Tuvalu's Ministry of Transport, Energy, and Tourism. Due to Tuvalu's limited land area, the solar panels will run along the landing strip at Tuvalu's airport alongside the soccer field. The contract price for the solar PV facility was about \$5 million, with the remaining funding provided by IDA.

The Government of Tuvalu worked with the e8 group to develop the Tuvalu Solar Power Project, which is a 40 kW grid-connected solar system that is intended to provide about 5% of Funafuti's peak demand, and 3% of the Tuvalu Electricity Corporation's annual household consumption. [2]

The World Bank said on Monday it will grant USD 7 million (EUR 6.2m) to help the island nation of Tuvalu achieve its objective of generating 100% of its electricity from renewable sources by 2020.&lt;/p&gt;

This will reduce the reliance on imported fuels for power generation, reducing the cost of generation by replacing diesel power with solar power. The project is expected to displace 6.7 million litres of diesel fuel and avoid 17,800 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent in greenhouse gas emissions over its lifetime.
