With these opportunities in mind, the government has set ambitious targets for expanding solar energy in Cambodia, aiming to inject 2 GW of solar energy into the grid by 2030. This goal is supported by a range of policies designed to facilitate the growth of the solar sector, including incentives for investment and development.

Where are solar power plants located in Cambodia?

Currently, solar power plants providing a total of 160 mW are located in Bavet city, Svay Rieng province, Kampong Speu province, and Kampong Chhnang province. Cambodia's existing solar power stations are already generating energy and linked to the grids.

How many Cambodian households use solar energy?

Approximately one third of a million households, or 8.4% of overall Cambodian households, are currently using off-grid or micro-grid solar (Cambodia Socio-Economic Survey). In 2016, there wasn't a single solar plant in the country.

Today, Cambodia's domestic energy mix is largely dominated by hydropower and coal, which respectively account for 46% and 48% of supply. Current Status of Renewable Energy in Cambodia - Biomass Energy and Solar Power As of 2021, Cambodia saw over 51% of the country's domestic energy production come from renewable sources. The majority was sourced from hydropower (44.17%), while solar and biomass accounted for around 7%.
