Basseterre Valley Solar PV Park is a 35.7MW solar PV power project. It is planned in Saint George Basseterre, Saint Kitts and Nevis. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently at the under construction stage. It will be developed in a single phase.

The UAE has allocated one plant for St. Kitts and the other for Nevis. Each plant can produce 12 cubic metres of fresh potable drinking water per hour. If the plant runs for 24 hours, it can produce up to 76,000 gallons of water daily. The electricity needed to power the desalination plant will be generated on-site from solar photovoltaic (PV ...

The solar PV will supply St. Kitts with 30 - 35% of the annual electricity demand utilising sustainable, solar energy with zero emissions. The solar and storage system will replace over 4,000,000 gallons of diesel per year.
