In the second week of May, the solar photovoltaic energy production registered a record maximum hourly value in Portugal, adding to the streak of records for this technology in Europe during 2023.

Portuguese Decree-Law 162/2019, of October 25 and the Self-Consumption Regulation published on March 20, 2020, have changed the rules for accounting for the energy produced and consumed by solar panels, which translates into a greater benefit for all owners of solar self-consumption installations.
