

Will Solomon Power deliver cheaper electricity outside Honiara?

The cheaper renewable energy delivered through the project will ensure Solomon Power, the country's state-owned electricity supplier, can deliver cheaper power, including outside Honiara. The total project cost is expected to reach US\$240 million over the next 5 years.

How much is the Solomon Islands infrastructure project worth?

The financing package for the project, worth over US\$200 million, through loans and grants from six institutions, marks the first large-scale infrastructure project for Solomon Islands to be developed as a public-private partnership (PPP).

Why are energy costs so high in the Solomon Islands?

Solomon Islands Government energy division director John Korinihona rejected any accusation of corruption or self-interest from the government as a cause of the high energy costs, and instead pointed to a planned "tariff reduction" to help reduce costs.

How does the World Bank support Solomon Islands?

The World Bank is currently committing more than US\$196 million in active projects and support to Solomon Islands. In addition to the Tina River Hydro Project, this includes a further US\$19 million to improve access to renewable energy, as well as US\$51 million to improve roads and airports, and US\$25 million to supporting rural development.
