

How much solar power will South Korea get?

The South Korean Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy has launched a tender for fixed-price solar PV and wind projects, looking for 2.8GW of new renewable power capacity. The tender will be split into two parts, with 1.8GW allocated for wind--itself split between 1.5GW for offshore wind and 300MW for onshore wind--and 1GW allocated for solar PV.

What is solar PV output in South Korea?
