5 ??· In Korea, electricity demand is concentrated in the northern Seoul metropolitan area, but the richest RE resources lie in the south (i.e., Jeollanam-do and Gyeongsang-do), and transmission capacity between the two areas is limited. Figure 4 shows Jeollanam-do is projected to account for 30% of Korea's solar and 25% of its wind power generation.
