

Where are South Sudan's new investments coming from?

Most of the new investment has focused in and around Juba--the nation's capital and largest city, with some 403,000 residents. "There's a lot of wealth that is coming with the peace now," said Jacob M. Deng, director of planning and projects for South Sudan Electricity Corporation, the nation's sole electric utility.

Does Sudan have enough energy?

Following the separation of oil-rich South Sudan from Sudan in 2011, Sudan has struggled to provide enough energy from sustainable sources to satisfy the growing needs of domestic household, industrial, and agricultural consumption [6].

Is result based financing a solution to South Sudan's energy crisis?

Result Based Financing (RBF) to accelerate access to energy services, an instrument commonly used in other markets to bridge the affordability gap, is also lacking in South Sudan. The energy sector's policy and enabling regulatory environment is still in its formative stage, especially for the off-grid sector.

Does South Sudan need electricity to drive industrial development?

Electricity prices in South Sudan are twice the prices of electricity in Africa and are five times the prices in other developing countries (Ranganathan and Briceno-Garmendia, 2011). As a resource rich country that needs to attract direct foreign investment, South Sudan definitely needs power to drive industrial development.

Is South Sudan a good place to buy energy?

Based on independent sources from consumers and suppliers, most off-grid energy products available in South Sudan are neither standardised nor quality verified. This hinders uptake, as many households reported quality to be a main factor in their purchase decision, especially in urban areas.

Where do South Sudanese consumers buy solar products?

Unlike other markets in East Africa, most South Sudanese consumers purchase off-grid solar products from general merchants and retailers, rather than directly from off-grid companies or specialised distributors.
