

Will India supply liquefied natural gas to Sri Lanka?

This marks Disanayaka's first foreign trip since becoming president in September. India plans to supply liquefied natural gas to Sri Lanka's power plants and will work on connecting the power grids of the two countries as well as lay a petroleum pipeline between the neighbours, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced on Monday.

How India & Sri Lanka rekindle energy ties?

India and Sri Lanka Monday (December 16, 2024) adopted a futuristic vision to expand their partnership, resolved to soon conclude a defence cooperation pact and decided to ramp up energy ties by establishing electricity grid connectivity and multi-product petroleum pipelines.

Work will be done to establish electricity grid connectivity and multi-product petroleum pipelines, Mr. Modi said, adding India will supply liquefied natural gas to the island nation's power plants.

How much power does Sri Lanka need?

Sri Lanka must add significant capacity to meet current and future power demand, which is forecast to grow at around 5 percent annually. Sri Lanka has total electricity generating capacity of 40 GWH, as it mainly relies on thermal power, including a Chinese-built coal power plant, which accounts for 45 percent of its supply.

When did wind power start in Sri Lanka?

The wind power sector of Sri Lanka saw its first activity in the year 1988 as research was conducted to establish a pilot wind project in the Southern Province (Juleff, 1996). Out of the many renewable energy options present, wind power is often considered the most economically viable and environmentally friendly source for Sri Lanka.
