

# Standard methods for energy storage testing

What is energy storage performance testing?

Performance testing is a critical component of safe and reliable deployment of energy storage systems on the electric power grid. Specific performance tests can be applied to individual battery cells or to integrated energy storage systems.

What is a stored energy test?

The goal of the stored energy test is to calculate how much energy can be supplied discharging, how much energy must be supplied recharging, and how efficient this cycle is. The test procedure applied to the DUT is as follows: Specify charge power  $P_{cha}$  and discharge power  $P_{dis}$  Preconditioning (only performed before testing starts):

Should energy storage safety test information be disseminated?

Another long-term benefit of disseminating safety test information could be baselining minimum safety metrics related to gas evolution and related risk limits for creation of a pass/fail criteria for energy storage safety testing and certification processes, including UL 9540A.

Are energy storage systems safe?

There is a responsibility to guarantee the safety of these systems, not only for daily operation but also in the face of adverse conditions or unforeseen events. Fire hazards, thermal runaway and other risks associated with energy storage systems must be thoroughly understood and mitigated to ensure public safety and prevent costly incidents.

What tests should a single piece of equipment go through?

A single piece of equipment shall go through type tests, production tests, installation evaluation, and commissioning tests as a whole.

What materials are needed to perform tests on an integrated ESS?

**Apparatus and Materials** The materials needed to perform tests on an integrated ESS are an electrical connection to the electric power system (EPS), metering to collect accurate data, and a control system to implement user commands.
