### Why do hydraulic systems store fluid under pressure?

The storage of fluid under pressure serves several purposes in hydraulic systems. In some hydraulic systems it is necessary to maintain the system pressure within a specific pressure range for long periods of time. It is very difficult to maintain a closed system without some leakage, either external or internal.

### How do accumulators store pressure?

Accumulators store pressure in a reservoirin which hydraulic fluid is held under pressure by an external source. That external source can be a compressed gas, a spring, or a weight. They are installed in hydraulic systems for two main purposes: to store energy and to smooth out pulsations.

### What is fluid storage & transport?

fluid storage can occur by multiple mechanisms including adsorption and compression, fluid transport can occur by multiple mechanisms including Darcy and non-Darcy flow, and horizontal wells, hydraulic fracturing, or other innovative completion/technology is required to produce CBM at commercial rates.

## What is a pressurized reservoir?

A pressurized reservoir is required in hydraulic systems where atmospheric pressure is insufficient to maintain a net positive suction head (NPSH) to the pump. There are two common types of pressurized reservoirs -- fluid-pressurized and air-pressurized. Some aircraft hydraulic systems use fluid pressure for pressurizing the reservoir.

What is a hydraulic system pressure vessel?

The primary function of a hydraulic system pressure vessel is to act as a storage tank for the hydraulic fluid. It helps to ensure a constant and reliable supply of pressurized fluid, which is necessary for the operation of various hydraulic components and machinery.
