What is the best way to store solar energy?

At the current stage, the highest artificial photosynthesis efficiency can reach 22.4%.⁶ An alternative way of storing solar energy is to use photoswitchable molecules. This concept was first proposed in 1909 by Weigert,^{7,8} who suggested using anthracene dimerization for solar energy storage.
