The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the government of Mongolia have inaugurated a 10 MW solar power plant in Mongolia's Govi-Altai province. The project is part of the Upscaling Renewable Energy Sector Project, which aims to deploy 40.5 MW of solar and wind capacity in the country's Altai-Uliastai regions.

This project is the first solar power generation project with battery energy storage system in Mongolia attached, which was awarded to the JGC Group in consortium with NGK Insulators (Japan) and MCS International (Mongolia) ...

The Darkhan Solar Power Plant is a photovoltaic power station in Khongor, Darkhan-Uul Province, Mongolia. It is the first solar farm in Mongolia. History. In July 2016, the signing ceremony between participating companies to construct the power plant was held in Ulaanbaatar. The construction of the power plant began in August 2016.

Mongolia is estimated by the National Renewable Energy Laboratory to have good-to-excellent wind resources of over 2,550 terawatt-hours per year. When including moderate-level wind resources, or those suitable for rural power applications, this estimate increases to over 8,123 terawatt-hours per year.

In a solar energy record for round-the-clock power generation, Mongolia's Wulate 100MW trough CSP project ran continuously for 12 days, generating pure solar energy without batteries; due to the thermal energy storage in CSP. While solar has been very effective for families not connected to the central power grid, utility scale PV power was foreign to Mongolia until 2014 when the first grid connected plant was completed. While the plant only supplied one hundredth of a percent of Mongolia's total electricity demand, it was the vanguard for a wave of solar construction.

Once operational, the Darkhan 10MW Solar PV plant will reduce greenhouse gas emissions by approximately 14,764 metric tons per year, and it is expected to be capable of generating enough electricity for more than 20,000 homes, Solar Power International LLC (SPI) estimates. "The Darkhan 10MW PV plant is the first Mongolian mega-scale PV plant.
