

What is pumped storage?

Pumped storage might be superseded by flow batteries, which use liquid electrolytes in large tanks, or by novel battery chemistries such as iron-air, or by thermal storage in molten salt or hot rocks. Some of these schemes may turn out to be cheaper and more flexible. A few even rely, as pumped storage does, on gravity.

What is pumped storage hydropower (PSH)?

U.S. DOE (2018) "Global Energy Storage Database Projects." Pumped storage hydropower (PSH) long has played an important role in America's reliable electricity landscape. The first PSH plant in the U.S. was constructed nearly 100 years ago. Like many traditional hydropower projects, PSH provides the flexible storage inherent in reservoirs.

What are the UK's first pumped storage hydropower schemes?

Another first was recently announced by Gilkes Energy in the UK, who released details of its planned 900MW Earba Storage Project in Scotland, the company's first pumped storage hydropower scheme. Earba Storage Project will store up to 33,000 MWh of energy, making it the largest such scheme in the UK in terms of energy stored.

How does a pumped storage hydropower project work?

Pumped storage hydropower projects use electricity to store potential energy by moving water between an upper and lower reservoir. Using electricity from the grid to pump water from a lower elevation, PSH creates potential energy in the form of water stored at an upper elevation, which is why it is often referred to as a "water battery".

How many pumped storage plants are there?

There are 43 PSH projects in the U.S.<sup>1</sup> providing 22,878 megawatts (MW) of storage capacity<sup>2</sup>. Individual unit capacities at these projects range from 4.2 to 462 MW. Globally, there are approximately 270 pumped storage plants, representing a combined generating capacity of 161,000 (MW)<sup>3</sup>.
