

What is the Kapolei energy storage project?

The Kapolei Energy Storage project is a utility-scale battery farm with a storage capacity of 565 megawatt-hours of electricity, making it the largest storage project in Hawai'i. It officially went online before the holidays after several delays.

How does a large scale battery storage system benefit Oahu's electricity grid?

Large scale battery storage systems like KES benefit the local electrical grid by providing resiliency and flexibility from a non-emitting capacity resource. Moving toward 100% renewable energy on an island grid such as Oahu's will require balancing resources like KES that can quickly adapt to evolving grid conditions over time.

Will a storage battery help Hawaiian Electric deal with over-generation?

A storage battery project has not yet proven its effectiveness at scale, according to Bob Rudd, the chief commercial officer at Plus Power. The battery's capacity will help address the issue of clean energy curtailment, also known as over-generation, for Hawaiian Electric, Rudd said.

What is the largest energy storage project in San Francisco?

The Kapolei Energy Storage facility in Hawai'i is the largest storage project in the state, with a storage capacity of 565 megawatt-hours of electricity. It is under construction in 2022. The project's developer, San Francisco-based Plus Power, believes it is the first time a battery has been used by a major utility to balance the grid.

What is Plus Power doing at Kapolei Harborside roadway?

Plus Power is coordinating with the landowner to make plans for access to the site consistent with the Kapolei Harborside Roadway Master Plan. Received CUP-m approval with the understanding that final civil drawings will be submitted to the HFD for review and approval.

Could a KES battery plant save solar energy?

The KES battery plant in Kapolei, Hawai'i, could save 69% of solar energy that would otherwise be destroyed in its first five years of operation, according to Hawaiian Electric's modeling.
