What is the University of the Gambia?

The University of the Gambia is a fairly new institution established by an Act of the National Assembly of the Gambia in March 1999. It comprises four faculties and Gambia College, including four schools: Agriculture, Science, Education, Nursing and Midwifery and Public Health.

What is the literacy rate in the Gambia?

The literacy rate in the Gambia is 63.9% for males and 47.6% for females. In the Gambia, 67% of children aged 3-4 are developmentally on track according to the Early Childhood Development Index. A greater percentage of girls are developmentally on track compared to boys (69% versus 65%).

In the past two decades, available data of UNESCO Institute for Statistics (UIS) show that the tertiary education participation in the country has been steadily increasing.
