

## **The cost of energy storage system depends on**

How much does energy storage cost?

Assuming  $N = 365$  charging/discharging events, a 10-year useful life of the energy storage component, a 5% cost of capital, a 5% round-trip efficiency loss, and a battery storage capacity degradation rate of 1% annually, the corresponding levelized cost figures are  $LCOEC = \$0.067$  per kWh and  $LCOPC = \$0.206$  per kWh for 2019.

Are mechanical energy storage systems cost-efficient?

The results indicated that mechanical energy storage systems, namely PHS and CAES, are still the most cost-efficient options for bulk energy storage. PHS and CAES approximately add 54 and 71 EUR/MWh respectively, to the cost of charging power. The project's environmental permitting costs and contingency may increase the costs, however.

How much does storage cost?

Regarding the storage reservoirs, the estimated costs vary more significantly, from 10 \$/kWh (7.5 EUR/kWh) to 169 \$/kWh (126 EUR/kWh). In addition to the specific features of the site, the cost of storage depends on the plant size, 69 \$/kWh (52 EUR/kWh) for a 14.4 GWh plant while 103 \$/kWh (77 EUR/kWh) for 11.7 GWh storage capacity.

What are the different types of energy storage costs?

The cost categories used in the report extend across all energy storage technologies to allow ease of data comparison. Direct costs correspond to equipment capital and installation, while indirect costs include EPC fee and project development, which include permitting, preliminary engineering design, and the owner's engineer and financing costs.

Are energy storage systems cost estimates accurate?

The cost estimates provided in the report are not intended to be exact numbers but reflect a representative cost based on ranges provided by various sources for the examined technologies. The analysis was done for energy storage systems (ESSs) across various power levels and energy-to-power ratios.

What drives the cost of storage?

This paper argues that the cost of storage is driven in large part by the duration of the storage system. Duration, which refers to the average amount of energy that can be (dis)charged for each kW of power capacity, will be chosen optimally depending on the underlying generation profile and the price premium for stored energy.
