By utilizing the Earth's regulated temperature the only thing that needs power from your solar system is going to be the heat pump itself. To power your appliances using solar power, you will need to have the right inverter. While an all-in-one inverter is both cheaper and easier to set up, it comes with some significant drawbacks.
