

How many rooftop solar PV systems will be installed in Turks & Caicos?

The contract outlines the installation of five rooftop solar PV systems, with battery energy storage and accessories at the following critical public facilities: These rooftop solar PV systems are specially designed for resilience to withstand fierce climatic conditions in the Turks and Caicos Islands.

What is happening in the Turks & Caicos Islands?

The Turks and Caicos Islands (TCI) Government continues to move towards a more sustainable and secure future with the execution of the Contract Agreement by HE Governor Dileeni Daniel-Selvaratnam for and on behalf of the TCI government and the contractor, Green Revolution Ltd, for the installation of five (5) solar photovoltaic systems.

Does Turks and Caicos have a policy on energy efficiency?

Turks and Caicos has few policies related to energy efficiency and renewable energy. Historically, the territory has not implemented policy mechanisms to aid in the development of clean and energy-efficient technologies.

Turks & Caicos Utility Limited (TCU) is wholly owned by FortisTCI and provides electricity to Grand Turk and Salt Cay. In 2010, the government of Turks and Caicos contracted with a consultant to draft recommendations for exploring the use of renewable energy and energy efficiency technologies to create a more sustainable energy framework.

The UORE program credits participants monthly for rooftop space over 20 years and grants a share of the system production annually. FortisTCI currently has 1.6 MW of solar on the grid and targets 33% RE ...
