

What does DOE do for remote and island communities?

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) today announced it will work with 11 remote and island communities around the United States and provide federal assistance to bolster their energy infrastructure, reduce the risk of outages, and improve their future energy and economic outlook.

Why do remote and island communities pay the highest energy costs?

"Residents of remote and island communities face energy disruptions, natural disasters, and climate change impacts and pay some of the nation's highest energy costs," said Secretary of Energy Jennifer M. Granholm. "These 11 communities--working hand-in-hand with DOE's network of experts--will implement resilient and secure clean energy solutions."

What is Block Island's energy plan?

Block Island, Rhode Island is looking to identify renewable energy sources that can be used to generate electricity on the island and reduce reliance on imported electricity and fuels. The community will engage in energy planning to shore up its resilience, particularly in the face of sea-level rise.

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Today, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) welcomed 25 new coastal, remote, and island communities to the Energy Transitions Initiative Partnership Project (ETIPP) as the technical assistance program's fourth cohort.
