

What makes a microgrid a reliable system?

High system reliability and generation placement flexibility can be achieved by a peer-to-peer concept, ensuring no specific component is critical for the microgrid operation, and a plug-and-play model, implying a unit can be placed at any point on the electrical system without needing to re-engineer the controls, for each microgrid component.

The U.S. Virgin Islands (USVI) includes the three main islands of St. John, St. Thomas, and St. Croix. The U.S. territory has a population of about 87,000 000 (U.S. Census Bureau 2022), and the primary industry is tourism (CIA 2023) . USVI is highly reliant on fossil fuel for their energy and all fuels are imported.

In 2020, the Virgin Islands Energy Office secured funding to develop a solar-plus-storage microgrid pilot project at the St Croix Educational Complex's emergency shelter, and expects to replicate this project as a resiliency standard at other critical government facilities.
