

What are the different types of solar panels in the UK?

Monocrystalline and polycrystalline solar panels are the two most common types of solar panel in the UK. In the coming years, monocrystalline will take a significant lead over polycrystalline in terms of popularity, as all the best solar panels on the market now are made with monocrystalline.

How much does a monocrystalline solar panel cost?

Monocrystalline solar panels cost around 20% more than polycrystalline solar panels. On average, monocrystalline solar panels cost $\pounds 350$ per square metre (m^2), or $\pounds 703$ to buy and install a 350-watt (W) panel. Polycrystalline panels, on the other hand, cost around $\pounds 280$ per m^2 , or $\pounds 562$ for a 350 W panel.

How are polycrystalline solar panels made?

Polycrystalline solar panel cells are made from silicon-crystal fragments, which are melted together and shaped into square wafers. The silicon-crystal fragments give polycrystalline panels a dark blue colour.

How long do monocrystalline solar panels last?

Monocrystalline solar panels typically have a longer lifespan than polycrystalline solar panels, but only by a few years. Both types of solar panels will last over 25 years - but monocrystalline panels can last up to 40 years, while polycrystalline panels can usually make it to 35 years.
