

## Unpacking the costs of chemical energy storage

Is chemical storage a promising option for long term energy storage?

Comparison of storage technologies according to the global efficiency, CAPEX and LCOES--based on a Hedegaard and Meibom (2012) and J&#252;ch (2016),<sup>b</sup> Gallo et al. (2016),<sup>c</sup> Elishav et al. (2017). With respect to these observations, the chemical storage is one of the promising options for long term storage of energy.

Can energy storage technologies help a cost-effective electricity system decarbonization?

Other work has indicated that energy storage technologies with longer storage durations, lower energy storage capacity costs and the ability to decouple power and energy capacity scaling could enable cost-effective electricity system decarbonization with all energy supplied by VRE.<sup>8,9,10</sup>

Why is chemical energy storage important?

In that regard, chemical energy storage in synthetic fuels (e.g., P2G), and in particular, renewable production of green hydrogen and ammonia may be critically important to achieve clean, scalable, and long duration energy storage. Similarly, batteries are essential components of portable and distributed storage.

Are mechanical and chemical storage systems suitable for achieving Target costs?

Several mechanical and chemical storage systems may be suitable for achieving these target costs.

Is battery storage a cost effective energy storage solution?
