What is Vortex Spring energy storage?

The vortex spring energy storage is a purely mechanical structure, which can realize the storage of elastic potential energy. Its processing and manufacturing are simple, maintenance is easy, and the cost is extremely low compared with other methods.

How to analyze the performance of vortex-induced energy harvesters?

To solve this problem, this paper presents an equivalent circuit modeling (ECM) method to analyze the performance of vortex-induced energy harvesters. Elastic energy storage technology has the advantages of wide-sources, simple structural principle, renewability, high effectiveness and environmental-friendliness.

What determines the mechanical energy storage capacity of a spring?

The mechanical energy storage capacity of the spring depends on the elastic deformation of the materials that is correlated with their modulus and yielding strain.

Can a spring-based mechanical energy storage system be used as a power supply?

However, the spring-based mechanical energy storage system has been rarely used as an active power supply for mechanical systems, largely due to its low energy density (around 0.14 kJ kg -1 or 0.04 Wh kg -1 for steel spring [19]) and the additional conversion from mechanical energy to electricity.

What are the functions of elastic storage device using spiral spring?

The principal functions of elastic storage device using spiral spring are energy storage and transfer in space and time. Elastic energy storage using spiral spring can realize the balance between energy supply and demand in many applications.
