How is water treated in Warsaw?

Water collected about 7 meters below the bottom of the river is then treated at the Central Plant (in two Warsaw treatment stations: "Filtry" and "Praga"). The Northern Plant in Wieliszew, on the other hand, supplies the city with surface water taken from Lake Zegrze. Over 330 million litres of water are used every day in Warsaw.

How much water is used in Warsaw agglomeration?
