

How is transient water hammer flow induced?

In all the research papers, the transient water hammer flow was induced through valve closures (both hypothetical-instantaneous and realistic valve closing performance) and/or by deactivating the pump power, mirroring the conditions often encountered in real-world operational systems.

How big is a water hammer in a 3D pipe?

In their paper, water hammer in a straight 3D pipe (36 m long with relatively large inner diameter  $D = 0.3$  m; Reynolds number  $Re = 7 \times 10^5$ ) during an axial gate valve closure was modeled using CFD.

Is pumped hydro energy storage station flexible?

The pumped hydro energy storage station flexibility is perceived as a promising way for integrating more intermittent wind and solar energy into the power grid. However, this flexible operation mode challenges the stable and highly-efficient operation of the pump-turbine units.

What is pumped hydro energy storage system (PHES)?
