What type of gas is used in a GIS substation?

They are insulated by a dielectric gas, Sulfur Hexafluoride (SF6). Air insulated Switchgear (AIS) units utilize atmospheric air as the gas medium, and are generally located in outside environments. In a GIS substation, the electrical components are enclosed in a metal structure with SF6 gas.
