What is a hydropower facility in Solomon Islands?

A hydropower facility to transit power system in Solomon Islands from diesel generated to clean and renewable energy. Universal grid-connected electricity supply is a major challenge across the 90 Solomon Island's inhabited islands.

Is hydropower a sustainable option for Solomon Islands?

Hydropower is also the most economically sustainable option in the long term. As Solomon Islands moves towards a cleaner, more sustainable energy future, having a mix of energy sources is the best solution for Solomon Islands; one which includes hydro, solar and battery storage.

Which areas of Honiara are being extended?

The project to extend the 11 kV and 415 V network in the Tinge Ridge, Baranamba/Ohuiola, Tasahe B, 7 Up, Green Valley/Mt Austin and Lungga/Markwarth, Tinge and GBR areas of Honiara have been completed. The extensions at Redbeach and Foxwood are in progress.

How long does the Tina River hydropower project last?

The project has an estimated lifespan of 50 years. 02 Aug 2019 /The Green Climate Fund (GCF) and the World Bank have signed an agreement to implement the Tina River Hydropower Development Project to help the Solomon Islands transition from diesel-generated to clean, renewable energy.

Is hydropower a viable energy source for Tina?

Studies conducted also show that using Hydropower for Tina is a less expensive energy source than other energy projects under consideration, e.g. geothermal and solar energy. Hydropower is also the most economically sustainable option in the long term.

Does Solomon Island have a grid-connected electricity supply?

Universal grid-connected electricity supply is a major challenge across the 90 Solomon Island's inhabited islands. The electrification rate is only around 45%, and many rural areas served by small PV panels, whilst the state-owned power utility SIEA is almost entirely dependent upon diesel generators for supply to the capital.
