Here, by doping equimolar Zr, Hf and Sn into $\text{Bi}_4\text{Ti}_3\text{O}_{12}$ thin films, a high-entropy stabilized $\text{Bi}_2\text{Ti}_2\text{O}_7$ pyrochlore phase forms with an energy density of 182 J cm^{-3} and 78% efficiency.
