What would happen if there were no energy storage?

Without energy storage, the costs of the energy transition would be higher. Countries would need to "overbuild" wind and solar plants or look at other ways of integrating renewable energy, such as by managing demand -- asking consumers to use less electricity because the wind is not blowing, for example -- or importing electricity from abroad.

Why is electricity storage important?

Depending on the extent to which it is deployed, electricity storage could help the utility grid operate more efficiently, reduce the likelihood of brownouts during peak demand, and allow for more renewable resources to be built and used. Energy can be stored in a variety of ways, including: Pumped hydroelectric.

Will electric power companies pay for storage?

Electric power companies and ISOs will pay for storage, if they decide to install it. "The price of storage is coming down. The price of solving the problems in other ways is going up. Pretty soon, these prices are going to cross," notes Boyes, suggesting cost could spur the addition of storage to the grid.
