I actually just installed a Franklin 2 battery system with the generator module, and it is a small Champion 7000 watt (continuous) inverter/generator, and it worked great when we tested the generator backup. It is NOT one of those huge whole home Generac or Kohler home generators.

The average person won't need a battery system this big, but it's great if you have a large home and want to go off-grid. And, the scalability ensures you only pay for what you need even if you need much less than the maximum capacity. It's super efficient. As a DC-coupled battery with 98% efficiency, very little energy is lost.

The link you shared is more of a portable power bank/"generator" as marketing calls it, and not a whole home system. Look at Victron (their website) for the system components, and just find a battery(s) that fits your power needs & budget (couple/few of these ought to do it). Lithium is the new wave and has many upsides, but you could also ...

Back wall, side wall, doesn't matter. The point is that it's fully committed to batteries. If you have home improvement plans for something else in the future, then you are very restricted. I know of at least one battery addon that would have given the same amount of storage with the space that just two of those Enphase modules take up.

Each enphase battery provides 3.6kW 3.84kW of continuous power and has 8.97kWh 10.08kWh of capacity. Install two you get double this, three and triple etc. The problem with AC coupled batteries (like enphase) is the batteries themselves need to be counted as part of the system's backfeed to the grid.

No doubt. If backup is secondary, TOU is primary, maybe someday wanting to go solar, the standalone batteries are growing more common. I'm a C-10, and offer both Generacs, Tesla powerwalls, and Encharge system. Something for everyone! ... Just large enough to cover those blips and to cover a minute of runtime until my Generac whole home ...
