How does a circuit breaker work?

To protect against these very high currents, circuit breakers have an electromagnetic coil inside. This coil generates a magnetic field inside the breaker that's proportional to the amount of current that will trip it. When that threshold is reached due to a sudden inflow of current, the magnetic field trips the breaker nearly instantaneously.

How does Eaton circuit breaker work?

The two-step stored energy mechanism is used when a large amount of energy is required to close the circuit breaker and when it needs to close rapidly.
