Why are circuit breakers important?

Circuit breakers are essential in safeguarding electrical systems by stopping the flow of electricity when excessive currents are detected. These safety mechanisms ensure that power systems are not subject to dangerous conditions such as overloads or short circuits.

How do circuit breakers work?

Today's circuit breakers incorporate both thermal and electromagnetic tripping mechanisms, which react to excessive heat and current respectively. If designed and installed correctly, these mechanisms protect circuits from damage due to electrical faults or overloading.

How does Eaton circuit breaker work?

Eaton's residential, miniature and molded case circuit breakers utilize over-toggle mechanism. The two-step stored energy mechanism is used when a large amount of energy is required to close the circuit breaker and when it needs to close rapidly. The major advantages of this mechanism are rapid reclosing and safety.

How do magnetic Breakers work?

Concurrently, the magnetic aspect, when encountering a surge, activates a magnetic force robust enough to sever the circuit, providing rapid intervention in the event of a sudden short circuit. As the technology evolved, so too did the variety and specificity of breakers.
