

Where will a solar plant be built in Yemen?

Masdar, an Abu Dhabi-based renewables developer, is set to build a 120 MW solar plant in Yemen. The developer signed a joint cooperation agreement with Yemen's Ministry of Electricity and Energy earlier this month. The deal includes the construction of transmission lines and transformer stations. The solar project will be built in Aden.

Why is Yemen a good place for solar energy?

Yemen has one of the highest levels of solar radiation in the world, increased solar irradiation availability throughout the year. Yemen has a long coastline and high altitudes of 3677 m above sea level, making it an ideal location for wind energy generation, with an estimated 4.1 h of full-load wind per day.

What is the Yemen emergency electricity access project?

In June 2022, the Bank approved an additional US\$100 million for the second phase of the Yemen Emergency Electricity Access Project, which is designed to improve access to electricity in rural and peri-urban areas in Yemen and to plan for the restoration of the country's power sector.

Is Yemen planning a solar plant?

In a previous interview with the platform, Kalshat said that Yemen was planning to develop solar plants each with a capacity in the range of 10 MW to 20 MW and up to 70 MW.

How much wind and solar power does Yemen need?

Therefore, the remaining power of wind and solar energy is about 33.59 GW and according to case two, the total power required which is 9.648 GW needed by the Yemeni population in 2030 only accounted for about 18% of the total available power of 52.886 GW of wind and solar power, and the remaining power is 43.238 GW.
