

What is a zebra battery?

The ZEBRA battery is a type of rechargeable molten salt battery based on commonly available and low-cost materials - primarily nickel metal, the sodium and chloride from conventional table salt, as well as beta-alumina solid electrolyte. It is technically known as the sodium-nickel-chloride battery, and sometimes as a sodium-metal-halide battery.

Who makes Zebra batteries?

The company AEG Anglo Batteries GmbH funded by joint venture started the pilot line production of ZEBRA batteries in 1994. After the merger of Daimler and Chrysler, AEG Anglo Batteries GmbH was terminated. MES-DEA succeeded the ZEBRA technology and industrialized the battery.

Are Zebra batteries cell failure tolerant?

The ZEBRA battery is cell failure tolerant. It has been established that 5-10% of cells may fail before the battery can no longer be used. The battery controller detects this and adjusts all operative parameters.

Are Zebra batteries suitable for electric vehicles?

Zebra batteries have several features that make them attractive for electric vehicle applications. Nickel chloride is preferred for these batteries, and Zebra batteries based on this cell reaction have been developed to the pilot-line production stage. The batteries can be assembled in the discharged state, eliminating the need to handle liquid sodium.

What is the difference between zebra and Na-S batteries?

... In the 1980s, the Zeolite Battery Research Africa (ZEBRA) group developed the 'ZEBRA' batteries using $\text{Na}_2\text{O} \cdot 11\text{Al}_2\text{O}_3$ as the solid electrolyte. So far, the Na-S battery has been commercialised in Japan, whereas the ZEBRA battery is currently being developed by the General Electric Corporation in the United States.
